OVERVIEW

The גמרא relates that רב יוסף סיט owned date palms and the גמרא (those who draw blood) would sit under these trees and do their work there. Ravens would come there, on account of the blood and the ravens would then settle on the trees and ruin the dates. רב יוסף wanted to chase the אומנים away, so אביי asked him, 'the are merely a גרמא should they be required to leave. גרמא the situation

בקרקע שלהן היו יושבין² ולא בקרקע של רב יוסף מדפריך בתר הכי והא³ גרמא הוא: These רב יוסף were sitting on their own land, and not on s'אומנים land, since אביי אביי subsequently challenged רב יוסף saying, 'but it is merely a 'גרמא' so how can you be justified in sending them away.

SUMMARY

The אומנים did their work on their own land.

THINKING IT OVER

The גמרא later argues that the אומנים should have a right to continue there since, אחזיק להו' meaning they have a חזקה. Why therefore is it necessary to say that it was their land, we can say it was s' riop' land, and nevertheless he could not remove them since ince !!⁴

³ If however they were sitting on רב יוסף' land, obviously he has the right to chase them away, therefore we must conclude that the אומנים were practicing their craft on their own land.

¹ They are only an indirect cause of the damage which was done by the ravens not by the אומנים.

² The trees were certainly on r = r = r land. However immediately adjacent to the trees (perhaps even under the extended branches) the land belonged to the אומנים. Therefore רב יוסף could not send them away for they were not on his property.
