Wherever it is applicable by selling, it is applicable by slaughtering, etc.

Overview

The גמרא explained that the reason ר' שמעון did not establish the ruling of ריש לקיש did not establish the ruling of אמים by קדשים תמימים, but rather by בעלי מומין, because the פסוק compares מכירה therefore we rule that only where there is a מכירה by היוב is there a חיוב for שביחה but by קדשים תמימים, but by קדשים תמימים where there is no מכירה.

תוספות responds to an anticipated difficulty:

ימוכר בשבת דחייב אף על גב דאם טבח¹ פטור² ההיא בהמה איתא בטביחה³ בחול:

And regarding selling on שבת, where he is ד' וה' for 'הייב, even though that if he slaughtered it on שבת he would be פטור, so why is he מכירה for מכירה; the answer is, because one would be liable for slaughtering this בהמה on a weekday

Summary

There is a difference between the inability of paying 'ד' for selling תמימים, than the lack of payment for שחיטה בשבת.

Thinking it over

Seemingly there is a more fundamental difference between תמימם of תמימים, which is virtually impossible, and the שחיטה בשבת which is possible and more importantly there is a חיוב to pay 'דיוב מיתה. 4

¹ If one was שוחט the animal on שבת there would be no payment of 'ד' because since there is a חילול for הילול and 'Thinking it over'. שבת we apply the rule of קם ליה בדרבה מיניה and there is no monetary payment. See מניה and 'Thinking it over'.

² The היקש of וטבחו או should go both ways; just like the גמרא גמרא states ליתיה בטביהה דליתיה במכירה, the same should be in the opposite manner that ליתיה בטביחה (on שבת because of (() () ()) it is ליתיה במכירה.

³ In the case of קדשים תמימים, therefore there is no liability of מכירת תמימים, therefore there is no liability of מכירת תמימים, as well; however regarding this animal that was sold on שבת, even though had it been שבת on שבת there would be no 'ד' וה', nevertheless this animal can be שבת the rest of the week, where there will be a ד' וה' therefore if it was sold (even) שבת, there is a 'ד' payment.
