OVERVIEW

The גמרא says that we need to examine the נייר with מיא נמרא to verify whether it was written במי or not. רש"י explains that נרא is a dye called and we spread the מי נרא over the תוספות cites a different view.²

פירש רבינו חננאל מי קליפת רימון וכן בערוך3:

The π "ה explained that מיא דנרא is the extract of the bark of a pomegranate tree,⁴ and similarly in the ערוך it is also explained in this manner.

SUMMARY
