The explanation is that the phrase ולאפוקי מהאי תנא, is referring to the תנא מושל, is to exclude from both of the לאפוקי'; however the intention of the לאפוקי' is to exclude from both of the ברייתא that are mentioned in the ברייתא. The cited ברייתא was taught by a certain who mentions the opinions of two other תנאים (namely משנון בן מנסיא and אסעון בן מנסיא משנון בן מנסיא משנון ברייתא disagrees with the ברייתא who taught the ברייתא and by extension, also disagrees with both תנאים.
